

Please note:

- a) **Entry conditions:** only members of GNAS are permitted to shoot at this Tournament. Competitors must quote their current GNAS membership number on the Tournament entry form. Archers are not required to conform to GNAS dress regulations.
- b) **Juniors:** Under 18s pay Junior Fee for any of the rounds shot, and can elect to shoot higher, but not lower, age range rounds.
- c) **Novice:** Is an archer who is in his/her first year of affiliation to GNAS.
- d) **Team Award:** There is no requirement to nominate a team; all archers must be from one club and can be either senior or junior. The medals will be awarded to the highest accumulated score.
Recurve: 3 archers. Team trophy and medals.
Compound: 2 archers. Medals only.
- e) **Awards:** All awards, except prizes and medals, will be held for one year or to the next Tournament, whichever is sooner and remain the property of The Company of Scorton Archers.
- f) **Trophy Holders:** All current holders are requested to return them engraved and in a clean condition to the organisers before the Tournament commences.
- g) **Refreshments:** Coffee, tea and light refreshments will be available.
- h) **Raffle:** A raffle will be held at the end of shooting before the awards ceremony.
- i) **Photography/Videoring:** Anyone (whether a competitor or not) wishing to take photographs etc must register with proof of identity at the check-in-desk on arrival at the event.
- j) Whilst every reasonable effort will be made to prevent unauthorised photography, filming or videoing taking place, the tournament organisers cannot be held responsible for any breach of this policy.

Awards:

Seniors: Lady and Gent: Recurve, Longbow and Compound 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Novice Archer 1st for all three disciplines. Wheelchair Archer. Recurve and Compound Teams. Scorton Archers only award.

Juniors: Awards for all bow disciplines and novice status will be made according to entries in age groupings and not gender.

Seniors and Juniors: Best Gold; Worst White, Most Greens and Lady Paramount Award.

From A1 North:

- Slip road for A6136 to Catterick (one after Scotch Corner)
- After approx 1 mile straight over traffic lights at large crossroads
- First right into Bridge Road opposite pub 'Farmers Arms'
- Under A1 flyover
- First left into Honey Pot Road.
- First left to sports field, follow road around and the field is hidden on the right at the end of the road – behind the houses.

From A1 South:

- Slip road for A6136 to Catterick, turn right and then left at the T-Junction. Drive through Catterick Village.
- Sharp left bend (racecourse on the left), then sharp right bend past Catterick Bridge Hotel (on the right) and over the bridge.
- Turn left into Bridge Road opposite pub 'Farmers Arms'
- Under A1 flyover
- As above.
